YEAR END AWARD ELIGIBILITY RULES

- To be eligible for year end awards, exhibitors must be current members in good standing of the Armstrong Enderby Riding Club and volunteer a minimum of five hours. (Not all five hours need to be done at once; they can be split between the five shows. No volunteering means **not being eligible** for year end awards.)
- Only shows entered after the membership date will be counted. Memberships will not be retroactive for the purpose of accumulating points.
- In order to be eligible for a year end perpetual award, *the same horse/rider combination must have competed in at least three of the five shows* offered this season.
- Keepers (ribbons and/or awards) will be presented to high point and reserve high point winners in each category.
- Year end perpetual awards are offered to the same exhibitor/horse combination accumulating the most points overall.
- Trail/Handy Horse, Pleasure Pairs, Green and Games points will not count for age division or overall awards.
- Points from classes not offered by age division (ie Western Pleasure Mares) will be extracted and added to their respective age divisions.
- Showmanship classes will count toward their respective English or Western and Overall high point.
- AERC members will be given the opportunity to nominate and vote for members eligible to win "Members Choice" awards **at each show**. A ballot box will be placed at shows and members will be invited to nominate suitable candidates for the awards by signed ballot throughout the show season. An overall winner for each award will be announced at the year end awards banquet. Members may be nominated in consecutive years for the same award. Each annual winner will receive a keeper award in addition to the perpetual, which shall be returned to the club prior to the following year's award presentation.
- A tie breaker shall determine the sole high point and reserve high point in each category. The horse and/or exhibitor with the most first placings will receive the high point.
- Points will be awarded using the following scale:
